Later, after all four of her children were in school, she worked for many years at Virginia Tech, first as a secretary-bookkeeper for the Department of Business Administration and then as office administrator and accountant for the School of Forestry and Wildlife Resources before retiring to take care of her husband in his years of declining health. Elizabeth helped map numerous caves in the Southeast in the early years of their marriage and was an active member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Blacksburg, VA. Part of her ministry was to be a companion and give Holy Communion to shut-ins and those who lived in long-term care facilities.
