December 16, 1921 - February 1, 2018

Mr. Henry 'Bert' Toney, age 96 of Conyers, died Thursday, February 1, 2018. 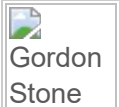

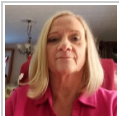
