

Billy Camp Rivers

May 31, 1932 - February 3, 2024

Billy, age 91 of Conyers, died February 3, 2024. He attended Brown High School. He married the love of his life, Rosebud "Buddie" Rivers on May 23, 1952. During his first year of marriage, he was drafted into the Army and served during the Korean conflict in Alaska where he was accompanied by Buddie. 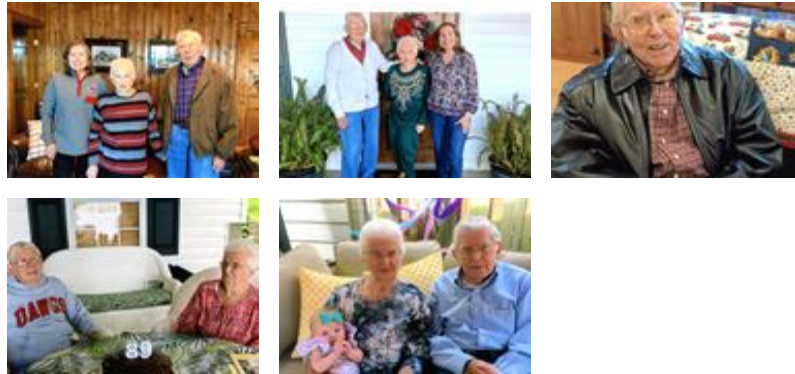
