



## Chandler Schmalz

Mr. Alfred Chandler Schmalz, age 88, passed away Sunday, June 23, 2013 in Conyers, GA. Born in Dedham, MA, he was preceded in death by his parents, Edith Young and Alfred Schmalz, his sister, Nancy Schmalz Barlow, and his first wife, Jane Isaac Schmalz. At Bolles Military Academy in Jacksonville, FL he taught chemistry and coached baseball. He then worked as a research chemist for 36 years at Hercules Inc., patenting many new products in the areas of man-made fibers and paper making chemistry which continue to be produced today. He was an avid Atlanta Braves, Boston Red Sox and Bruins fan. He enjoyed gardening and was a member of the Azalea Society for many years. He was an active member in the Episcopal and later the Lutheran Church.
