Mr. Charles Ray Ott, age 93, died peacefully on October 25, 2013, following a brief illness. He was born on March 18, 1920 to Nellie (Miller) Ott and Charles Andrew Ott in Conneaut, Ohio. Charlie graduated from Case Institute of Technology (now Case Western Reserve University) in Cleveland, Ohio, with a degree in Chemical Engineering. Charlie was married to his college sweetheart, Ms. Jessie (Brunton) Ott in 1943. They were married 69 years. He worked for the Diamond Shamrock Company for 40 years, retiring as a Vice President. This job involved positions in Painesville, Ohio, Muscle Shoals, Alabama and Newark Delaware. After retiring, he and Jessie relocated to Conyers, Georgia. He then became an entrepreneur, starting the CR Ott Pool Services Company, which he enjoyed running for 20 years before selling the business at age 80. Charlie and Jessie enjoyed traveling to many countries and being actively involved in the community. Charlie was the president of the Irwin Place Homeowners Association in Conyers for many years. He is survived by two children, Dr. Cathy Ott (Eugene) Blusiewicz of Atlanta and Charles A. (Ursala) Ott of Newark, Delaware; grandchildren, Scott A. Blusiewicz and Robin L. (Charles) Kirby.
