“ I am very saddened to hear of Wayne's passing. Our family lived next door to the Wilsons on Marianna Street in Memphis. Wayne and I graduated together from Messick High School in 1959. As children we had our ups and downs with each other, as kids are prone to do, but afterwards we were back playing together again.

There were many children living on Marianna Street in the fifties and now, sadly, at least four of them, including Wayne, are now deceased. The others are Connie Cook, Sandra Holcomb, and Gorman Avery.

Wayne helped pay my way through college. Wayne had a Memphis Press Scimitar paper route in a predominately black neighborhood and I would often go with him to deliver the papers. After about 6 months, Wayne decided to give it up and asked if I wanted to take it over and I agreed to do so. I kept the route for close to 6 years and saved \$1,000 selling newspapers for a paltry 30 cents a week but accumulated enough money to pay for college (remember tuition at Memphis State was only \$87.50 per semester).

One day I was helping Wayne on the paper route and a thug started threatening us and wanted to fight. The guy had some real boxing gloves and thought he was pretty tough. I knew Wayne could whip me so I asked Wayne if he would take him. Wayne put the gloves on the end of those long bony arms and with a reach advantage proceeded to give this guy a pretty good licking.

So many memories. I could go on all day.

My sincerest condolences to all the Wilson family who I knew on Marianna Street and to Wayne's wife and children.
