Curtis Ray Turner, born Dec. 6, 1934, went to his Heavenly home on May 2, 2014. He was preceded in death by his wife of 56 years, Susan Almgren Turner. He is survived by his mother, Mildred Turner of Newnan, GA; his three children, Cheryl Turner Marshall (David) of Naperville, IL, Curtis Ashley Turner (Dee Ann) of Peachtree City, GA, and Walter Vance Turner (Terri) of Clemmons, NC; grandchildren, Chad Marshall, Eric Marshall, Jessica Marshall, Trenton Turner, Trevor Turner, Trey Turner, Jordan Turner; brother, Bill Turner of Chattanooga, TN; sister Carolyn Fincher of Newnan, GA; nieces, nephews and great-nieces and great-nephews. Curtis served in the United States Coast Guard from 1955-1959. He protected the coastline from Cape May, NJ to Miami, FL. After returning, he graduated from GA State University with a degree in Accounting and eventually opened his own firm that provided full service accounting for over 40 years. Curtis was active in the Christian Church participating in church building and prison ministries at Mt. Carmel Christian Church, Decatur. Later he served as an Elder at Crosspoint Christian Church in Conyers and at McDonough Christian Church in McDonough where he lived for the last 22 years. His greatest passion was helping others and he provided church services to assisted living and nursing homes throughout the area for over 30 years. Curtis loved the Atlanta Braves. He was at Fulton County stadium for the first and last scheduled games ever played there, including the night Hank Aaron broke the home run record and also a World Series game. He also loved going to Georgia Bulldog football

games, playing golf and spending time with friends and family. Funeral services will be held Tuesday, May 6, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. at Scot Ward's Green Meadow Chapel with Ashley Turner officiating; interment will follow at Fairview Memorial Gardens.
