Mr. Elmer Franklin 'Frankie' Robinson, Jr., age 73 of Milstead/Conyers, died Monday, September 23, 2019. 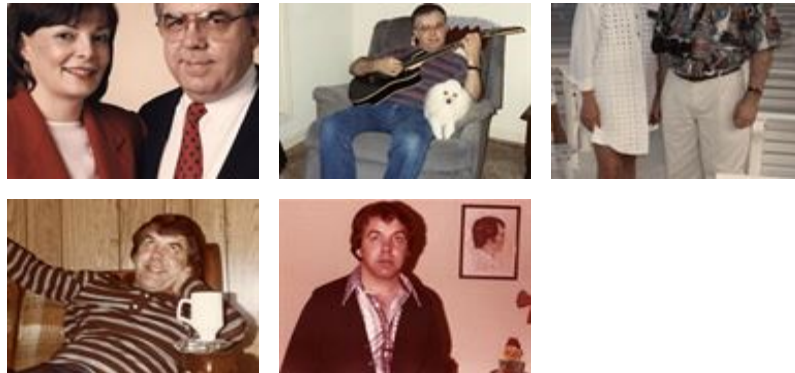
