We celebrate the remarkable life of Felton Thompson Floyd, who touched the hearts of many and peacefully departed on January 11, 2026, at the age of 88.

Born on September 19, 1937, in Danielsville, Georgia, to parents Calvin and Georgia Floyd, Felton later moved to Rockdale County, where he graduated from Rockdale High School. During his time there, he enjoyed playing football and building friendships. After high school, he proudly served in the Air Force for four years, demonstrating his dedication and commitment to his country.
