We thought we had done well, and each of us smiled, When he had congratulated us all, he stood back and said " congratulations, ya"ll have just completed the longest engine change in Delta history".

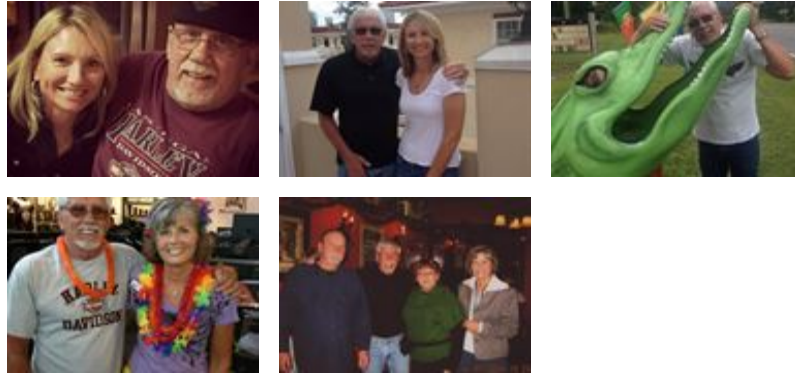
