Born on July 17, 1950, in St. Andrew's, Kingston, Jamaica, Franklin was the beloved son of Lisa Hazel Savory and Hughtus Augustus Williams. He was brother to Hugh "UU", the twin brother of Myrlin Williams, both whom preceded him in passing, and the younger brother of Wilfred Robinson.

A man of quiet strength and deep love, Franklin was low-key and private, but those who knew him best knew his heart was always with his family. He spoke with authority and conviction, and if ever questioned about it, his firm reply was always the same: "This is my tone of voice."

Franklin was a hardworking entrepreneur who built and managed multiple businesses, taking immense pride in his independence. His strong will and determination shaped the life he created, always striving to provide for his loved ones. He was also a skilled martial artist, holding a black belt in Shotokan karate, a reflection of his discipline and perseverance.

Despite his tough exterior, Franklin had a playful side—he had a knack for turning everyday statements into little jingle songs, bringing laughter to those around him. He also found joy in traveling, and some of his best memories were made on vacations with his nephew/son, the late Andrew Morgan.

Franklin is survived by his three children, Jehmira, Shamyra, and Jahkeem;

his cherished grandchildren, Jarod, Amoury, Katelyn, Nathaniel, Aniyah, Tamiyah, Journey, August, and Asher; his younger brother, Wilfred Robinson; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and close friends.

Franklin's legacy lives on in the strength of his words, the melodies of his jingles, and the love he poured into his family. His presence will be missed, but his spirit will never fade.
