We serviced 2 way radio equipment for fire departments and police as well as federal government accounts that didn't have radio technicians, were under warranty or had maintenance contracts. We go back a long time. I remember one morning over coffee at 7 corners Gary and I decided to install a 2-way radio in a car together doing it as fast as we could to see how long it would take from start to finish. He parked his van in the rear and I parked mine on the left side opened the doors hood and trunk threw the bottom of the rear seat onto the roof and it only took us 22 minutes. I turned 80 in June.
