Geraldine Chambers Bradford died Tuesday, September 11, 2012 at the age of 95. One of three children of the late Luther H. Sr. and Lassie Hunt Chambers, Geraldine was born November 24, 1916 in Cherokee County. Most recently, Geraldine was a resident of Mt. Vernon Towers in Sandy Springs; however, she previously lived in Conyers for over 35 years.
