Harold Hester, 70, died Wednesday, June 7, 2023 at Piedmont Rockdale Hospital in Conyers, Georgia. He was preceded in death by his wife, Jacqueline Hester; daughter, Erin Whitney Hester; mother, Margart Norma Wilmont; and father, Lindbergh Harper. Eventually, he moved on to become the Regional Director for Wesley Woods Senior Living over the Southeastern District. He truly found his niche. He contributed his success to the guidance of his mother, Margaret Wilmont.

While at Brenau University, he met a student there that became the love of his

life, Jacqueline 'Jackie' Hester. One thing Harold loved to do was dance and he loved music! He also loved his cars and both he and Jackie started a limousine business before he ended up retiring from Whole Foods. Afterwards, Harold prepared meals for the children at summer camps in Conyers, GA through one of the churches in the area for several years.

Harold loved his children, and he also had a great love for his younger brother, Troy Hester, who is in prison. He stated, 'I will put funds in Troy's account as long as I have breath in my body.' He lived up to these remarks! He visited Troy on a regular basis before the pandemic. He lost his wife Jacqueline and his daughter Erin and is now survived by his son, Dontrease. Also, he was cared for by his daughter, Kelly in his last days at their home.

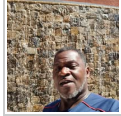
