Life of Harry Washington Bird

On Tuesday, August 9th 2022, Harry Washington Bird passed away peacefully at his place of residence. He was a loving husband, father, stepfather, brother, uncle, and dedicated brethren for the Church of God of Prophecy. Harry Washington Bird was born on September 9, 1939 to the late Edwin Bird and Maud Bird. He was born in Java District, Manchester in Jamaica. He was preceded in death by his brother, Clement Bird; sisters, Ida Bird, Roselyn Bird, Phyllis Hall, Alma Hall, and Loretta Hall Dailey.

Harry was baptized as a child at the Wesley Frankfield Methodist Church and he attended the Frankfield Elementary School. At age 16, he migrated to Vere, Clarendon where he worked. He attended the Lionel Town Church of God of Prophecy and this is where he was saved and baptized. Harry was successful on the farm work program in the late sixties. In 1969, on his third trip to America, Harry decided not to return to Jamaica. He was taken in by his Aunt Erma Burnett and this is where his journey of making a better life for himself, his mom, and siblings began. Harry worked for over 35 years as a doorman in New York at 280 Riverside Drive rental complex. He was a

dedicated member of the Bushwick Church of God of Prophecy for over 33 years and he served as an usher at this church.

Harry was a loving, caring, and friendly person. After 35 years of service at Riverside Drive, Harry retired and then decided to relocate to Conyers, Georgia. Harry continued his dedicated service in the New Dimension COGP. He was a lover of people and family. He enjoyed reading his Bible, serving his God, and doing his crossword puzzles. His favorite TV program was Pastor Jerry Black of the Beulah Baptist Church. Harry enjoyed life to the fullest. On the 9th of August, 2022 Harry went to be with the Lord. Left to mourn his passing are: his wife, Jeanette Rose Bird; son, Tindel Bird; daughter, Teal Bird; 3 stepchildren, 7 grandchildren; one brother, James Bird, nieces, nephews, church family, and other close relatives and friends.

Funeral service for the late Harry Washington Bird will be held Monday, August 29, 2022 at 10:00 AM at Scot Ward's Green Meadow Chapel with Bishop Lloyd Phipps and Revered Michael Daley officiating; interment will follow at Green Meadow Memorial Gardens. 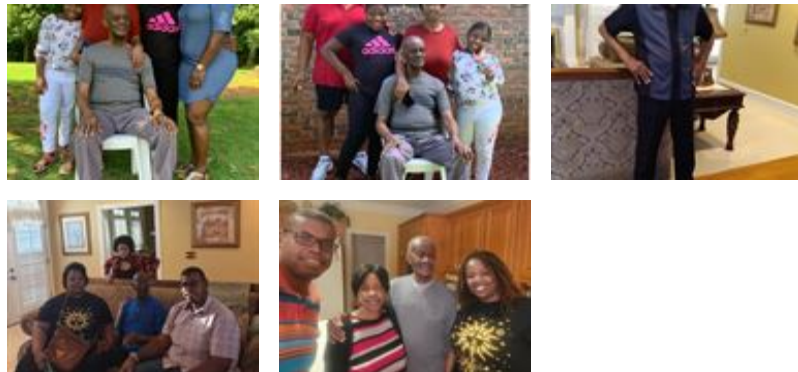
