



Hugh Whitaker Cornwell

August 24, 1922 - August 21, 2016

Mr. Hugh Whitaker Cornwell, age 93, of Hartwell, Georgia died Sunday, August 21, 2016 at the Anderson Medical Center in Anderson, SC. He served in WW II a little over 3 years in the Pacific Theater in the Army Air Corp as an armorer in the 528th Squadron, 380th Bomber Group (known as the Flying Circus), 5th Air Force. He was a Mason and long-time member of the Philologia Lodge #178, F & AM Masonic Lodge in Conyers, Georgia; past Grand Master from 1951-1953. He was a member of FBC Hartwell since moving there in 1981 and previously was a long-time member of FBC in his hometown of Conyers, having served on a number of committees and elected as a Deacon. After returning home in 1945, he worked as a materials engineer for 10 years in the Georgia Highway Department Lab. He retired after 25 years from Amoco Oil Company, Asphalt Sales Division, as an area sales manager. He was preceded in death by his parents, Ralph and Velta Whitaker Cornwell; brothers, Arthur Will, Barton and Vernon. He is survived by his wife of 69 years, Dorothy McCart Cornwell; sister, Annette Morgan, brother, Bob, Roy and sister-in-law Marti; sons and daughters-in-law, Larry and Nancy, Wayne, Keith and Karen; granddaughter, Kacy Lehn, husband, Trip and children, Carson, Brooks, Collin; grandsons, Jonathan and David Cornwell; numerous nephews and nieces.
