Mr. James Benjamin 'JB' Bryant, Jr., age 93 of Oxford, died Tuesday, October 12, 2021. Serving his country honorably in the United States Army during the Korean War, he was later employed at Continental Insurance and AFCO Premium Finance where he retired. He then set up a lawn service business and had 50 customers, mainly widowed women and elderly. An avid gardener, he planted huge vegetable gardens every year and always included his favorite flower, mixed gladiolus, and then donated food to anyone who wanted it. He loved sports, especially football, golf and fishing, and was a huge Georgia Tech fan. James was preceded in death by his parents, Eva Pearl and James Benjamin Bryant, Sr.; sister, Helen Brantley and her husband, Dewitt; brother, Charles Bryant and his wife, Reba.
