Jennifer 'Jae' Lynn Paul Harrison's long fought battle with Breast Cancer ended on Thursday May 2, 2019 in her hometown of Conyers, GA. She was 52 years old. Known as Jenny to her family and Jae to her friends, she was born in Atlanta on November 21, 1966. She was preceded in death by her parents, Bill and Janice Paul of Conyers, and was the youngest of their three children. 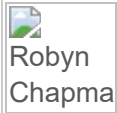
