Jesse Wallace (J.W.) Creasy, 91 years old of Lilburn, GA passed away peacefully on November 23, 2017. He was born on July 7, 1926. J.W. served in the United States Army as a Technician 5th Grade, 75th infantry division in the European Theater of Operations during WWII. He was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, WWII Victory Medal and Combat Infantry Badge. J.W. was honorably discharged on May 11, 1947 and graduated from the University of Georgia with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree. He married Vera Evelyn Stewart on December 20, 1952 and they had two children, Jeselyn and Jesse, Jr. They were members of the First Baptist Church of Conyers, GA. He worked as a property field specialist, and retired from Safeco Insurance Company.
