



## Jimmy Foster Breedlove

January 30, 1937 - December 6, 2016

Jimmy F. Breedlove, 79, passed away on Tuesday, December 6, 2016. Jimmy was a native of Atlanta. He graduated from Murphy High School in Atlanta in 1954 and Mercer University School of Pharmacy in 1963. He worked in Pharmacies in the East Atlanta, South DeKalb and Ellenwood areas. He later worked for Delta Airlines in the Pricing and Revenue Department from which he retired to take up the game of Golf. He was an avid fan of the game and played regularly at the Oaks Golf Course in Covington until he had to give it up after a fall that broke his wrist. He was preceded in death by his parents, Jewell and Jack Breedlove and his brother, David J. Breedlove. He is survived by his wife, Rosemary Yancey Breedlove; daughter, Jennifer; son, Jeff and his wife, Kathryn; grandson, Jack; and a host of nieces and nephews.
