June 30, 1948 - October 23, 2023

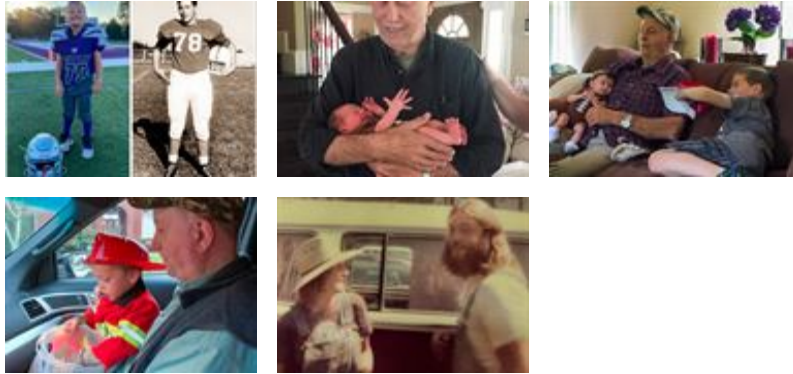
