Lt. Col. John W. Repetto, age 86 of Lawrenceville, formerly of Decatur, died Friday, June 19, 2015. 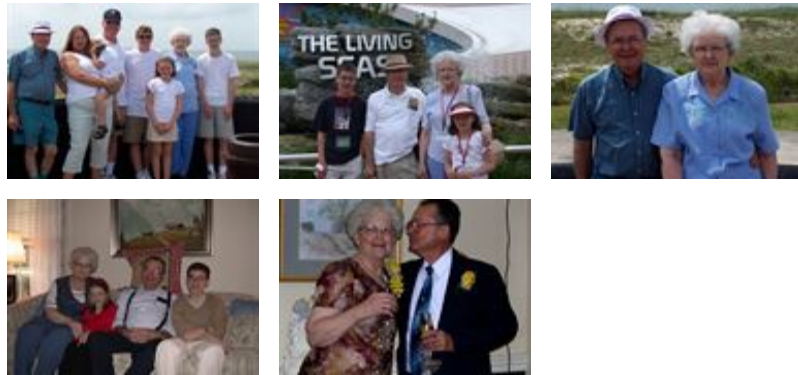
