Joseph John Bednarz Jr., age 70 of Conyers, died Wednesday, November 15, 2023.

Joe was the cherished son of Joseph J. Bednarz Sr. and Edith Cates Bednarz. Growing up alongside his brothers, Mathew (wife Phylis Bednarz and daughter Madison Bednarz) and Clay Bednarz (wife Sandra Bednarz and son Chase Bednarz), and sister, MaryAnne Cates (wife Melodie Drewyor-Cates), Joe's early years were shaped by the warmth and closeness of family bonds.
