



## Kenneth David Slaughter

May 18, 1940 - September 2, 2015

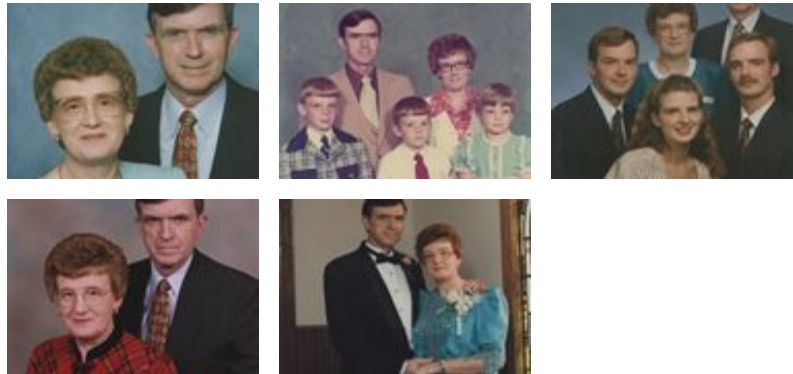
