



Lenora Agatha Robinson

September 14, 1942 - April 1, 2023

Lenora Robinson, a beloved member of the Conyers community, passed away on April 1st, 2023, at the age of 80, surrounded by her loving family. Lenora will be deeply missed and fondly remembered for the many lives she touched with her sense of humor, kindness, and thoughtfulness.

Lenora was born on September 14th, 1942, in St. James Jamaica, to Bereta Campbell and Eli Dennis. She graduated from Niagara High School in 1958 and pursued vocational training to become a Community Health Aide. Lenora dedicated 25 years of her life to serving the Ministry of Health until her retirement in 1998. She had a passion for helping people and tirelessly cared for the sick. Her commitment to serving others extended beyond her profession, as she was an active volunteer in her community and the Seventh Day Adventist Church.

Lenora was preceded in death by Celeste Watson, Stephen Watson, Eli Dennis, and Bereta Campbell. 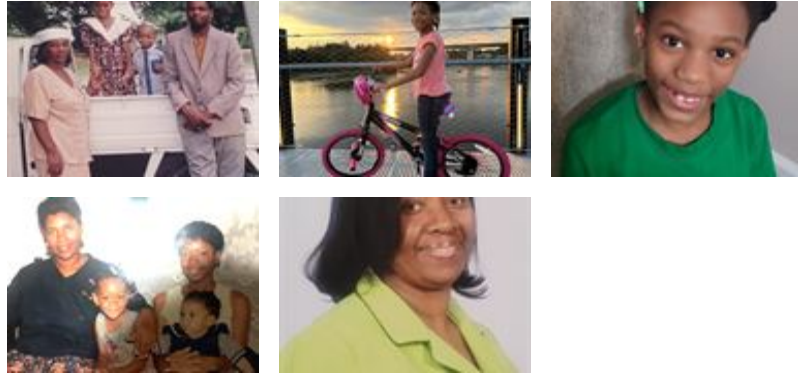
