Mr. Leonard L. Evans, Jr., age 92 of Conyers, died Wednesday, January 2, 2013. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 69 years, Mary Alice Evans; son, Ray Craig Evans; and grandson, Brant Duensing. He is survived by son, Leonard L. He was a member of GA State Trap Shooting Hall of Fame and a member of All American Trap Team for many years. His other hobby included photography and in his early years was a member of a camera club. Funeral services will be held Sunday, January 6, 2013 at 2 p.m. at Crosspoint Christian Church with Rev. Curt Zehner, Rev. Bill Rollins and Rev. Paul Leslie officiating; interment will follow at Green Meadow Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends Saturday from 4 to 6 p.m. at the funeral home.
