



## Louise Arnold

January 14, 1924 - May 22, 2015

On the afternoon of May 22, 2015, Louise Hobbs Arnold of Navarre, Florida, formerly of Conyers, Georgia passed away peacefully of natural causes in her home. She was 91 years old and was born on January 14, 1924 in Westville, Florida. Her parents were Henry Redden Hobbs and Laura Ledonia Anderson. She was married to the late Daniel DeLois "D.D." Arnold on May 10, 1941. Louise was employed by Guardian Life Insurance Agency in Atlanta where she was Office Manager and Cashier. Prior to that, she was employed by the Georgia International Life Insurance company also in Atlanta. She was an active member of the Pilot Club in Conyers and served as President during her membership. In addition, she was the National President of the Life Insurance Office Managers Association and received recognition as Cashier of the Year in 1974. She and D.D. were members of Heritage Hills Baptist Church in Conyers. Following D.D.'s death, she moved to Navarre, and joined the First Baptist Church of Navarre. She was an active member for many years and was a member of the Love Sunday School class. Louise enjoyed painting and travelling in their RV (lovingly nicknamed the "Minnie Winnie") throughout the Northeast Georgia mountains. They spent many weeks at the Unicoi Springs RV Park near Unicoi State Park in north Georgia. Louise was also an excellent photographer and an international traveler and enjoyed exploring new places. Louise was preceded in death by her husband "D.D", and her brothers, Edgar and Herbert Hobbs. She is survived by her children, Sylvia Fleetwood of Navarre, Florida and Larry Arnold of Rome, Georgia; four
