Marvelee loved and cherished her with every fiber of her being. Marvelee graduated from Mount Vernon High School and later received a Bachelor's degree in Health Services Administration. She was employed as a cashier for over 30 years where she exemplified the art of customer service. She was loved by her customers and co-workers alike. Marvelee lived a very simple and uncomplicated life. She didn't create any fuss or wanted any fuss created about her. She was a truly beautiful soul. She always spoke of being buried in

her Victoria Secret silk pajamas and her sneakers so she would be comfortable in her after life. And to that we say, 'Get your rest sweet Marvelous and Love Always'. 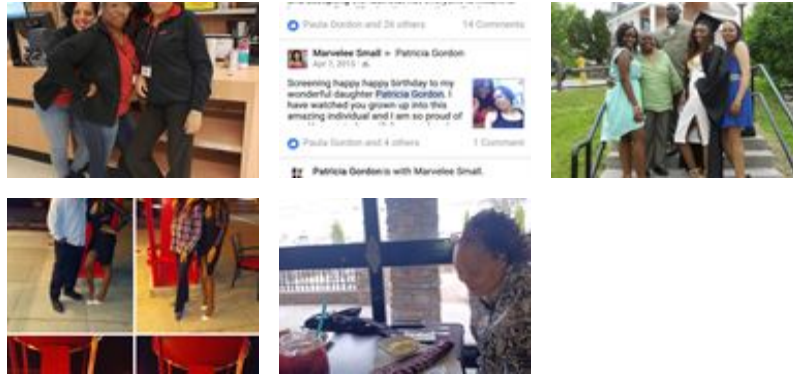
