



## Mary Kloeckler

July 3, 1916 - December 9, 2015

Mary Fideles Kloeckler, age 99, born on July 3, 1916, retired public relations representative of The Coca-Cola Company, died Wednesday, December 9, 2015 at Remington House in Conyers, GA after a long illness. She is survived by a cousin in Montana. She was a native of Atlanta, GA. In 1970, she moved to Lake Capri in Rockdale County, GA. The last several years she has resided at Remington House. A graduate of Georgia State University, Miss Kloeckler was employed by The Coca-Cola Company for 37 years. She was a secretary and a supervisor in the Bottler Sales Department prior to joining the Company employee magazine, THE REFRESHER, as assistant editor. 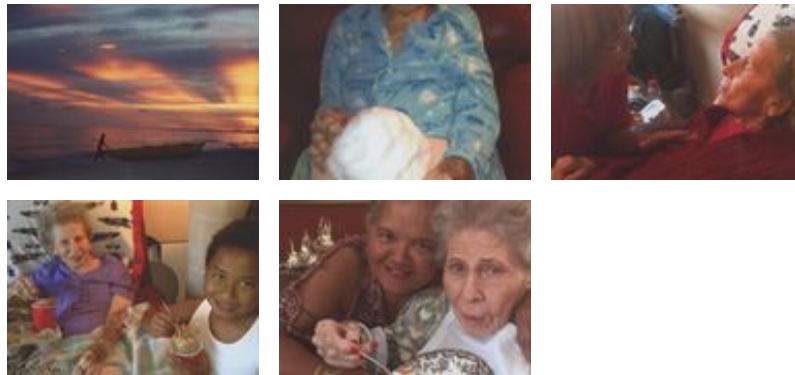
