Mrs. Mary Lucille Trammell McKenzie, age 100 of Conyers, went home to be with the Lord on Monday, October 10, 2016. She was born on February 15, 1916 to Martha Brubaker Trammell and Frank Marion Trammell. Her father was an ambulance driver at Grady Hospital in the late 1800's and her mother was a registered nurse at Grady where they met, fell in love and married. Mary was preceded in death by her husband, Van T. McKenzie; children, Billy McKenzie, Mary White (little Mary); parents, Martha and Frank Trammell; and siblings, James Trammell, Dan Trammell, Harriett Reeves, Helen Schrengost.
