



## Montie Anne Stone

October 13, 1968 - April 22, 2020

Montie Warren Stone, a lifelong resident of Atlanta, Georgia died peacefully in her sleep on April 22, 2020 at the age of 51. She was with her family at their mountain home.

She is survived by her father Johnny, her husband Todd, her children, Todd Lane Jr. and Leah Catherine, and her siblings, Catherine, Merrell, and John. Montie was born in Atlanta on October 13, 1968 to John B. (Johnny) and Esther Warren. She attended Christ the King School and Riverwood High School in Atlanta.
