He made everyone feel welcome and comfortable in his home. He was loving, caring, kind, and gentle to all. He was a protector and best friend to his wife, Blanche. They did everything together, including building his man cave which was his sanctuary and spent most weekends going on dates at Lowes. He would loudly play his Dominican music while hanging out in his mancave by himself, or with his family. He was loved by everyone he met. His loud, infectious laugh would have anyone laughing along with him. He gave everyone around him their own unique nickname, which was filled with meaning and marked one's heart. Once you were given a nickname by Nevo, you were never called anything else by him, and you knew this nickname was yours and only yours, and you wore it with pride. Nevo had a slick and quick comeback for everything. He would have you laughing at yourself, not even realizing that the joke was on you. It was expected by all who knew and loved him. He loved playing dominoes, but more than anything else, he loved debating politics with any willing participant and was not afraid to express his views respectfully. He was truly one of a kind and will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him. Funeral services will be held Saturday, January 28, 2023 at 2 pm at Scot Ward's Green Meadow Memorial Chapel.
