



Raymond Supple Sr.

January 9, 1925 - April 18, 2015

Mr. Raymond J. Supple, Sr., age 90, was born on January 9, 1925, to Francis and Josephine Sweeney Supple in Bridgeport, Connecticut, and passed away April 18, 2015, in Conyers. While serving in the 12th Infantry of the 4th Division in France and Belgium during World War II, Mr. Supple earned two Purple Hearts and numerous commendations.

After the war, he married his wife of 68 years, Madeline McMullen in Bridgeport. They later moved to Miami where Ray had a long career with Southern Bell, and later in Connecticut with Southern New England Telephone Company. After retiring, he moved to Conyers.

Always active, Ray continued to work as building and grounds superintendent for St. Pius X Catholic Church for over twenty-five years. He was a life-time member of the Knights of Columbus in Florida, Connecticut, and Georgia, and an avid golfer and family man.

Ray was beloved by all who knew him. In addition to his wife, he is survived by children, Raymond, Jr.(Mary); William; Maureen; and Patrick.
