Ms. Maurice 'Rece' Martin of Conyers, GA passed away on Sunday, February 14, 2016. She was born January 18, 1937 to Tom and Hazel Martin. She was raised primarily in southeast Georgia and graduated from Statesboro High School in 1954. She then completed two years of college at Georgia College in Milledgeville and received a BSN degree in nursing from Emory University in 1959. She then dedicated four decades of her life to a life-long dream of becoming a pediatric nurse at Egleston Children's Hospital (later known as Children's Healthcare of Atlanta). During this time she earned her Master's Degree in pediatric nursing from the University of Pittsburgh, PA in 1971. From Atlanta she moved to Conyers, GA to be closer to some of the family and became very active in Conyers First United Methodist Church where she sang and participated in two of the adult choirs. She was a lay pastor in the church and served in other volunteer activities. Rece is survived by her two brothers and sisters-in-law, Tom and Marcia of Conyers and John and Becky of Chattahoochee Hills, several nieces, nephews, great-nieces and nephews. A Memorial Service will be held Wednesday, February 24, 2016 at 2 p.m. at Conyers First United Methodist Church; family will receive friends from 1 until 2 p.m. prior to the service at the Church.
