Robbie Lee was a charter member of the Conyers Seventh-Day Adventist Church. The Celebration of Life will be held Sunday, March 8, 2015 at 2 p.m. at Conyers Seventh-Day Adventist Church with Pastor John Strickland officiating; interment will follow at Fairview Memorial Gardens, Stockbridge. Her remains will lie in state from 1 until 2 p.m. prior to the service at the church. Family will receive friends Saturday, March 7, 2015 from 7 until 9 p.m. at the funeral home. “Robbie Lee Davis Land passed away at the age of 87, March 4, 2015. Robbie Lee’s husband of 68 years, James, held her hand as she breathed her last in the presence of their four sons and family members.

Robbie Lee was born May 30, 1927 in Albany, Georgia. She was the youngest of 7 children of Eddie and Bertha Davis. Her father always referred to Robbie Lee as her baby. Growing up in Albany and Atlanta, and attended church school in Atlanta, graduating at age 17.

Robbie Lee married James Donald Land, Sr., in 1946 at the age of 19 in Atlanta, Georgia. James and Robbie Lee had their first of four sons, James Donald Jr (Don), then Charles Allen, Robert Conner and Frederick Michael. James Sr started his own accounting firm in 1971 and while raising four sons as a full time mom, she began working with James in the firm as it grew and continued to do so until the beginning of this year.

Robbie Lee’s great passions in life were Jesus, her family, her church and her home. Always active in the church, she was known to rarely miss even a Prayer Meeting service and hardly ever missed a single evangelistic meeting that came to town. She and James were founding members of the Conyers SDA Church and watched it grow from nothing to a membership over 600. Till her accidental fall Januray 11, she was still an active church greeter. The love of Jesus flowed so freely through her that many consider her their own mama regardless of race or social status, both within the church and where ever the regular path of James and Robbie Lee would take them. And hundreds took their prayer requests to Robbie Lee knowing that she would faithfully record them and lay the request at the feet of Jesus trusting Him with the response.

The void Robbie Lee leaves cannot be filled because of the unique way she let Jesus so completely fill her everyday with His sweet presence and love. Yet, those closest to her know that we will see

her soon, that same sweet spirit in a forever young and holy body when Jesus wakes her up to watch Him come for her and her family in that grand and glorious second coming.

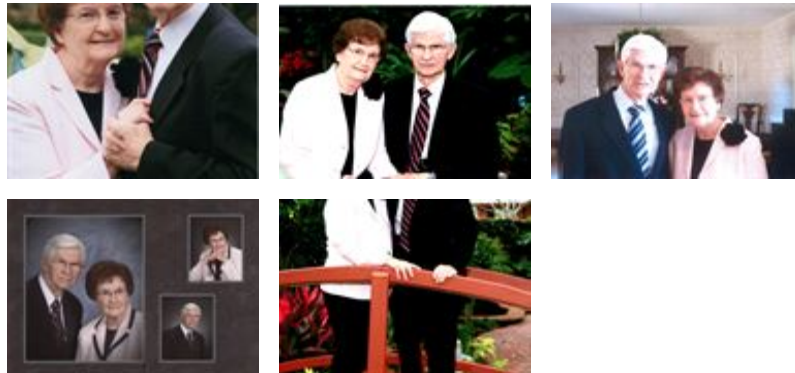
