Roger Royce Bell, age 80 of Conyers, passed away at home on Monday, November 12, 2018 after suffering from Alzheimer's for many years. He was preceded in death by his parents, Armistead and Pearl Bell, Harlowe, NC and 7 brothers and sisters.
