



Sabrina Taylor

February 14, 1956 - May 8, 2025

Mrs. Scarlet Sabrina Taylor (nee Brooks), aged 69, of Conyers, died peacefully surrounded by her family and friends on Thursday, May 8, 2025. She was preceded in death by her parents, James and Martha Brooks.

She is survived by her husband of 32 years, Michael Richard Taylor; two daughters, Abigail Michele Taylor and Jenny Lynn Taylor; brother, Jimmy Brooks; niece Rebecca Brooks; nephew, James Brooks III (McDonough); great nieces and nephews, Bonnie Huffaker, Sawyer Hughes and Atticus Hughes; aunt, Dotti Covington (Cumming); uncles, Derrial Green (Thomaston) and Gerrial and Carolyn Green (Thomaston); cousins, Tom Covington (Athens), Andrew Covington (Cumming), Tim Covington (Avondale Estates), Kimberly Larson (Thomaston), Amy Covington (Cumming), Derek Green (Thomaston), Brian Wilson (Thomaston), and Dusty Wilson (St Simons).

Sabrina dedicated her life to the care, education and enrichment of children. She spent 44 years as an elementary school teacher, more than 25 of those at Barksdale Elementary in Rockdale County. She was always there to support her own (and other people's children) at school plays, musical performances, sporting events, and awards ceremonies. Sabrina delighted in celebrating and nurturing talent and passion in young people and she was never happier than when surrounded by children. She was a wonderful wife, supportive and loving mother and caring, dear friend to many people.

When she wasn't teaching or cheering people on from the sidelines, Sabrina loved to travel, go to plays and musicals, explore new restaurants, and shopping (particularly at TJ Maxx). Many people would say Sabrina was the sweetest person they'd ever met and her kind, generous spirit will be deeply missed.

A celebration of Sabrina's life will be held on May 27 at 6pm at The Black Box Theatre, 910 Center Street, Conyers, GA, 30012. If you'd like to attend, please arrive at 5:30pm and let the family know so they can plan numbers for refreshments following the service. The family requests that you wear something that reminds you of Sabrina - whether that's something blue (her favorite color) or even a T-shirt with a character from your favorite children's book, they'd love to see the theatre filled with color to honor her.
