January 12, 1943 - June 8, 2012

Mr. Terry Whyte, age 69 of Conyers, died Friday, June 8, 2012 after a brief illness. He was born January 12, 1943 in Portland, Maine. He attended Bishop Gibbons High School in Schenectady, NY and then served in the United States Marine Corps from 1960 until 1964. Terry started his career in Portland, ME with Nabisco. He also worked for Ferraro USA as regional sales manager, where he covered the southeast. He retired as vice president of sales for CBA, Inc. in Kenner, LA.
