Mr. Theodore Blaschke, age 80 of Conyers, died Saturday, April 13, 2013. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Gretchen Anne Blaschke. He furthered his education with graduate studies finishing in 1963. He was a member of the Chi Epsilon Society and the Tau Beta Pi Society and a life member and certificated teacher of the RSCDS, Royal Scottish Country Dance Society. He founded the Atlanta branch of the RSCDS and was a life member of the Clan Donald and Clan Lindsay. He taught and danced with the RSCDS in Japan, Germany, Brazil, Italy, England, Canada, and throughout the United States. He was in the St. Andrews Society, Burns Club and active in the Stone Mountain Highland Games. He set up RSCDS dancing platform and dancing spread throughout the Southeastern area. He was co-founder of the summer week-long Society Thistle School RSCDS in Banner Elk, NC. More recently he was a member of the Conyers Lions Club.
