



Thomas Forrest Sellers

June 21, 1941 - February 7, 2015

Mr. Forrest Sellers, age 73 of Monroe, formerly of Conyers, died Saturday, February 7, 2015. He was preceded in death by his parents, E. J. and Hester Sellers. 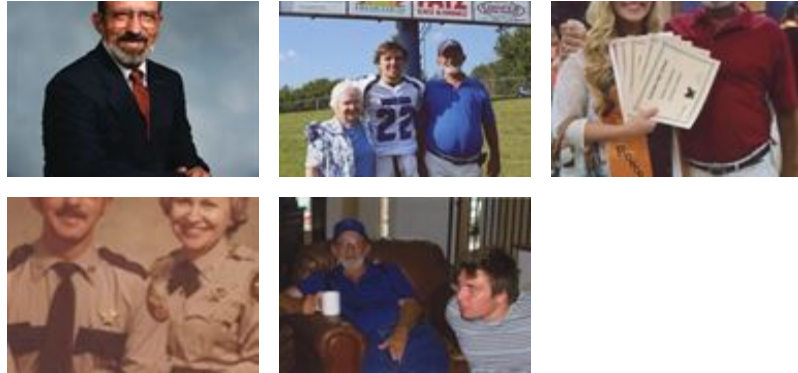
