He died Sunday night, October 19, 2014 due to complications following recent surgery. Tim was a lifelong educator beginning his career as a teacher in Montgomery, AL. He served most of his service years as a school administrator in Alabama, Virginia and New Hampshire. He has been a Special Education teacher at Heritage High School in Rockdale County since 2006. Tim loved his family. He is survived by wife, Jill Victoria Woodward; sons, Timothy C. Woodward, Benjamin K. Woodward, and Joseph A. Woodward; step-son, Luke M. Buckham; daughters, Carrie R. Woodward and Rachel J. Woodward; foster daughter, Tia Cast Leath; grandson, Jackson F. Woodward; sister, Camille Melton and her husband Thomas Melton. His son Joshua Woodward predeceased him. Tim had a great love of sports, especially Major League Baseball, Alabama Football and fishing.
