Wayne Franklin Hammonds, born October 17, 1930 passed away April 6, 2022 at age 91. He was surrounded by loved ones who will strive to honor his memory by living their life to the fullest. 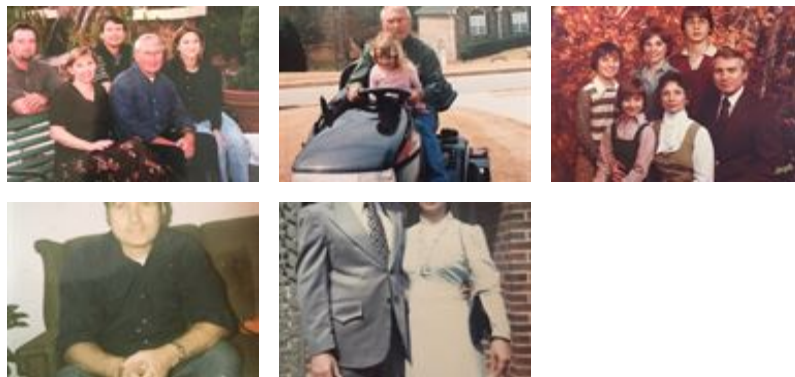
