William B. Peck, better known as Papa Bill, age 80 of Conyers, GA passed away on Wednesday, January 24, 2024, at Piedmont Rockdale Hospital. Bill was born October 10, 1943, in West Virginia to the late William P. Peck and Marguerite D. Peck-Hankins. He spent his childhood in the Beckley, West Virginia area and graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School. He then enrolled in the United States Air Force serving proudly for 4 years stationed in Guam during the Vietnam War. Following his time in the air force, Bill met and married the love of his life, Sarah E. Peck, to whom he had been married for 50 years. He then began his career working for the phone company in West Virginia. Through his work with the phone company, he was eventually transferred to Atlanta, GA where he, his wife, and sons would relocate to live in Conyers. He would continue to work for BellSouth until his retirement.

Bill was predeceased by his wife Sarah and one sister Peggy Crum. He is survived by his sons and daughters-in law Alan and Miranda Peck of Monroe, GA and Eric and Karen Peck of Bethel, AK; two grandsons Christopher and Ryan Peck of Monroe, GA. He is also survived by two sisters Alma Rae Pack (David) of MacArthur, WV and Donna P. Hitchens of Princeton, WV; along with several nieces and nephews.

Bill was an active member of the Truthseekers Sunday School class of First Baptist Church of Conyers. Services for Bill will be held Monday, January 29,
