*I first met Mrs. Winsome Bragg-Lawrence in 2006 while working at the Ministry of Agriculture in Kingston, Jamaica. From the very beginning, she adopted me as one of her own as she had done with so many other young people. She wasn't just a coworker; she became my work mother, my confidante, and one of my dearest friends.*

*Whenever our supervisors couldn't find us, they knew exactly where to check first, Mrs. Bragg's office. She created a space that radiated warmth, laughter, and safety. Many managers were quietly jealous of how effortlessly the younger staff gravitated toward her. But it wasn't favoritism it was love, sincerity, and that natural motherly spirit she radiated.*

*Mrs. Bragg treated us like her own children. And me? I had the honor of being her favorite son and her trusted driver. Whether it was to Church, the bank, work events, or casual outings, she insisted I be the one to take her. I gladly did because time with her felt less like passing hours and more like building bridges.*

*unwavering dedication to her church, her commitment to helping others, her regular visits to nursing homes to spend time with the elderly, and her joyful travels around the world with her sisters. *She had a way of creating fun, lighthearted environments wherever she went. One memory that always makes me smile is a trip to the supermarket with her and Barbara.
